महोदय/महोदया,

उपर्युक्त विषयक Bar Council of India द्वारा जारी पत्र संख्या BCI:D-4557/2026 दिनांक 13.07.2026 के क्रम में अवगत कराना है कि BCI द्वारा समस्त मौजूदा Centres of Legal Education (CLEs) को उनके वर्तमान विधि पाठ्यक्रमों, वर्गों (Sections) एवं स्वीकृत छात्र संख्या (Sanctioned Intake) के अनुमोदन के Extension/Renewal हेतु आवेदन प्रस्तुत करने एवं आवेदन प्रक्रिया को पूर्ण करने का अंतिम अवसर प्रदान किया गया है।

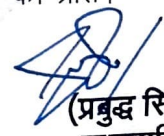
अतः विश्वविद्यालय से संबद्ध समस्त विधि महाविद्यालयों को निर्देशित किया जाता है कि वे BCI के पोर्टल पर अपने संस्थान से संबंधित आवेदन की स्थिति का तत्काल परीक्षण करें तथा यदि आवेदन अपूर्ण है, कोई दस्तावेज/शुल्क लंबित है अथवा कोई Deficiency प्रदर्शित हो रही है, तो उसे नियमानुसार पूर्ण/दूर करते हुए आवेदन प्रक्रिया पूर्ण करें।

साथ ही निम्न बिन्दुओं का विशेष रूप से अनुपालन सुनिश्चित किया जाए।

1. BCI पोर्टल पर आवेदन Final Submit किया जाना सुनिश्चित करें।
2. निर्धारित आवेदन शुल्क का पूर्ण भुगतान सुनिश्चित करें।
3. आवश्यक दस्तावेज, Affiliation/Consent of Affiliation, पूर्व BCI Approval Letters, Faculty Details, Infrastructure Details, Course-wise एवं Section-wise विवरण आदि आवश्यकतानुसार उपलब्ध कराए जाएं।
4. पोर्टल/ई-मेल पर प्रदर्शित किसी भी Deficiency/आपत्ति का समयबद्ध निस्तारण किया जाए।
5. यदि आवेदन पूर्व में पूर्ण रूप से जमा किया जा चुका है तो Duplicate Application प्रस्तुत न करें, बल्कि आवेदन की Final Submission एवं Fee Payment की स्थिति सत्यापित करें।
6. आवेदन पूर्ण होने के पश्चात उसकी Final Submission/Payment की रसीद एवं स्क्रीनशॉट सुरक्षित रखें।
7. यह सुनिश्चित किया जाए कि BCI की वैध स्वीकृति/Provisional Approval के बिना किसी ऐसे पाठ्यक्रम, Section अथवा Intake में प्रवेश न दिया जाए, जिसकी वैध स्वीकृति उपलब्ध नहीं है।

अतः आपको निर्देशित किया जाता है कि उपर्युक्त कार्यवाही को अत्यन्त प्राथमिकता एवं समयबद्धता के साथ सुनिश्चित करें तथा BCI द्वारा निर्धारित समय-सीमा में आवेदन प्रक्रिया पूर्ण कर अनुपालन सुनिश्चित करें। यदि अनुमति नहीं प्राप्त होगी ऐसी स्थिति में प्रवेश पर रोक लगाई जायेगी।

Sir/Ma'am,

The Bar Council of India has, from time to time, notified the procedure, applicable fee structure, timelines and regulatory requirements for registration and

v. The application shall be accompanied by all prescribed documents, including the current affiliation or consent of affiliation of the concerned University, previous BCI approval letters, faculty particulars, infrastructure details, course-wise and section-wise information, undertakings and all other documents required under the applicable rules, circulars and portal requirements.

vi. Any deficiency communicated through the portal, registered email address, official letter or any other authorised mode should also be rectified on or before 31.07.2026. The institution shall regularly monitor its portal dashboard and registered email account.

vii. An institution which has already submitted its complete application need not submit a duplicate application. It shall, however, verify that the application has been finally submitted, the applicable fee has been paid in full and no deficiency remains pending.

viii. Where an institution claims that its application has been completed but the portal continues to reflect an incomplete or pending status, it shall communicate the issue to the Legal Education Department of the Bar Council of India on or before 31.07.2026, together with its CLE code, application number, payment particulars, proof of final submission and relevant screenshots or supporting documents.

ix. Universities having affiliated law colleges shall immediately circulate this communication to every affiliated Centre of Legal Education and shall ensure that each existing Centre submits and completes the requisite application within the stipulated period.

x. This opportunity is confined to existing Centres of Legal Education seeking extension or renewal of approval for existing courses, sections and sanctioned intake. It shall not be construed as reopening the application process for establishing a new Centre of Legal Education, commencing a new course or seeking an additional section, unless specifically permitted by the Bar Council of India.

xi. Payment of the prescribed application, inspection, guarantee or other fee shall not by itself confer any right to approval. All applications shall be scrutinised in accordance with the Bar Council of India Rules of Legal Education, 2008 and the applicable resolutions, circulars and regulatory requirements.

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xi. Payment of the prescribed application, inspection, guarantee or other fee shall not by itself confer any right to approval. All applications shall be scrutinised in accordance with the Bar Council of India Rules of Legal Education, 2008 and the applicable resolutions, circulars and regulatory requirements.

xii. Submission of an application shall not constitute deemed, automatic or provisional approval. No institution shall admit students or represent that a course, section or intake is approved merely because an application has been submitted or is under consideration.

xiii. Admissions shall be made only against a course, section and intake covered by a valid approval or provisional approval issued by the Bar Council of India and valid affiliation granted by the concerned University.

xiv. Substantive deficiencies relating to faculty, infrastructure, affiliation, academic standards, sanctioned intake or compliance with the Rules of Legal Education, 2008 shall not stand condoned merely by submission of an application within the extended period.

All existing Centres of Legal Education are, therefore, directed to avail this final opportunity and submit and complete their applications in every respect positively on or before 31.07.2026.

Failure to submit and complete the requisite application within the stipulated period shall result in the concerned Centre of Legal Education being treated as having failed to avail the final opportunity. Upon expiry of the said period, the application window shall stand closed for such institution and no further extension of time shall ordinarily be granted.

Any application submitted after 31.07.2026 shall not be entertained, save pursuant to a specific decision of the competent authority of the Bar Council of India in exceptional and duly substantiated circumstances. No institution shall have any right to claim such further extension or consideration.

A Centre of Legal Education which fails to submit the requisite application within the prescribed period shall not be entitled to claim continuation or renewal of approval or to undertake admissions for the relevant academic session in the absence of a valid approval or provisional approval issued by the Bar Council of India. The concerned institution and University shall be responsible for all consequences arising from such non-compliance, including any prejudice caused to students.

All Universities are directed to ensure compliance by their affiliated Centres of Legal Education and to prevent admissions in any law course, section or intake not supported by valid approval of the Bar Council of India.

This circular shall be treated as final and urgent and is being issued as a facilitative measure in the interest of orderly regulation of legal education and protection of students.
